Window Replacement Project

Removal of Asbestos cement window panels in preparation of new windows.

Here at Midlands Asbestos Solutions Ltd we have recently completed a large asbestos removal project at a local hospital in the East Midlands on behalf of a large commercial client. The project involved removing Chrysotile asbestos cement external window panels to a single elevation spread over 6 floors of the building. This meant removing over 300 asbestos cement window panels over a 3-month period. We had an asbestos skip on site in a secure compound which was used to hold the waste once removal had taken place. The works commenced in the summer of 2017 and Midlands Asbestos Solutions were on site each morning to carry out the asbestos removal works to allow the window fixers to complete the replacement window works on a day to day basis. We carried out these works efficiently and on time to allow maximum reinstatement works throughout the project and completed the asbestos removal works in such a way that it caused as little impact as possible to the operational side of the hospital and did not impact at all on the public access into the hospital.
